Bill Analysis

SJR 16 refers to the people a constitutional amendment directing the state to uphold the right of a citizen to bear arms. The amendment would not prevent the Legislature from prohibiting the possession of arms by a convicted felon, a person convicted of domestic violence, a person adjudicated as mentally incompetent or a person who has been involuntarily committed in any mental institution.
