17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 528.7 of Title 57, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 Effective July 1, 2019, all employees of the Department of

1 and who were employed by the state on the last working day of June
2 2019, shall be awarded an increase of Two Dollars (\$2.00) per hour
3 over their current hourly wage.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

5 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
