HB 2286 clarifies OSBI procedures regarding the issuance of handgun licenses. The measure:

- Requires OSBI to conduct a check of the National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) prior to the issuance of a handgun license to a peace officer if no prior check is on file.
- Allows OSBI to notify license holders via email 90 days prior to expiration of a license.
- Clarifies that Oklahoma recognizes any valid concealed or unconcealed carry permit for any person who is not a legal resident of Oklahoma.
- Requires any person with a valid firearm license from another state to apply for a handgun license within 180 days of establishing residence in this state if the person carries a firearm pursuant to a firearm license.
