HB 2313 proposes new law to be codified as 68 § 208.1 stating that the Oklahoma Tax Commission, in addition to any form of notice required by law to be provided to a taxpayer regarding renewal of vehicle registration, shall provide such notice to the taxpayer in the form of an electronic notification, including but not limited to electronic mail using the email address or other form of electronic communication provided to the Tax Commission and designated by the taxpayer.
