C. The programs shall:

Promote proper nutrition and developmentally appropriate
 practices by establishing training and policies for program
 personnel;

Comply with the United States Food and Drug Administration's
Child and Adult Care Food Program nutrition standards for food and
beverages served to children;

10 3. Prohibit beverages that contain added sweeteners or 11 caffeine;

Provide opportunities for developmentally appropriate,
 inclusive moderate and vigorous physical activities, games and
 sports; and

15 5. Set limits on screen time to ensure that digital devices are 16 used for homework, research or digital learning that is active 17 rather than passive.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
