L7	the following proposed amendment to Section 17A of Article V of the

L 9	Section 17A. Any member of the Legislature who is elected to
20	office after the effective date of this amendment <u>January 1 of the</u>
21	year following the adoption of this amendment shall be eligible to
22	serve no more than $\frac{12}{20}$ years in <u>both houses of</u> the Oklahoma State
23	Legislature; provided a member of the Legislature shall be eligible

to serve no more than 12 years in either the Senate or the House of

    consecutive and years of service in both the Senate and the House of
    Representatives shall be added together and included in determining
