10	An Act relating to appropriations; making an
11	appropriation to the Department of Public Safety; stating purpose; providing lapse dates; requiring and
12	prohibiting certain budget procedures; and declaring an emergency.
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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
17	Public Safety from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
18	General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
19	ending June 30, 2021, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars
20	(\$100,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the
21	duties imposed upon the Department of Public Safety by law.
22	SECTION 2. Appropriations made by this act, not including
23	appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
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1 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 (hereafter FY-21), or may be 2 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 (hereafter FY-22). 3 Funds budgeted for FY-21 may be encumbered only through June 30, 4 2021, and must be expended by November 15, 2021. Any funds 5 remaining after November 15, 2021, and not budgeted for FY-22, shall 6 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal 7 year. Funds budgeted for FY-22 may be encumbered only through June 8 30, 2022. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2022, shall lapse 9 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. 10 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years 11 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-21 and not required to pay 12 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-22, after 13 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared 14 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds 15 from the FY-21 budget work program and after such revision has been 16 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. 17 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
