Marijuana Tax Revenue Fund and shall be expended in accordance with subsection C of this section.

- C. If proceeds from the levy authorized by subsection A of this section exceed the budgeted amount for running the regulatory office, any surplus shall be apportioned with seventy-five percent (75%) going to the General Revenue Fund and may only be expended for common education. Twenty-five percent (25%) shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma State Department of Health and carmarked for drug and alcohol rehabilitation
- There is hereby created in the State Treasury a fund to be designated the "Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Tax Revenue Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of monies received pursuant to subsection B of this section and any monies designated to the fund by law. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund shall be appropriated at the discretion of the Legislature for the purposes of:
- 1. Operation of the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority, State

  Department of Health;
  - 2. Substance abuse prevention and treatment programs; and
  - 3. Common education.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
