6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to administrative rules; providing
8 for sunset of rules; providing for joint review
9 committees; providing for membership of committees;
10 providing for review of rules during interim;
11 providing for codification; and declaring an
12 emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 250.11 of Title 75, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. Once every four (4) years all rules promulgated by every
18 agency, board and commission shall sunset.

19 B. During the year preceding the sunset of each agency's rules,
20 a joint review committee shall be formed by members of both the
21 Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma State Senate.

22 C. During the year preceding the sunset of each board's rules,
23 a joint review committee shall be formed by members of both the
24 House of Representatives and the State Senate.

1 D. During the year preceding the sunset of each commission's
2 rules, a joint review committee shall be formed by members of both
3 the House of Representatives and the State Senate.

4 E. The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint
5 five members of the House to each review committee, and shall
6 designate a chair in odd years and vice-chair in even years.

7 F. The President Pro Tempore of the State Senate shall appoint
8 five members of the Senate to each review committee, and shall
9 designate a chair in even years and vice-chair in odd years.

10 G. The membership for the review committees does not have to be
11 the same for each agency, board or commission.

12 H. Review of each of the rules shall be conducted during the
13 interim with a recommendation being made for the rejection and
14 removal of any rules as needed.

15 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
16 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
