6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending
8 Section 160, Chapter 366, O.S.L. 2016 (37A O.S. Supp.
9 2018, Section 6-120), which relates to furnishing
10 alcoholic beverage to persons under 21; requiring
11 certain program participation for violation; and
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 160, Chapter 366, O.S.L.
15 2016 (37A O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 6-120), is amended to read as
16 follows:

17 Section 6-120. A. Any person who shall sell, furnish or give
18 alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age
19 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor for a first violation, and upon
20 conviction shall be fined not more than Five Hundred Dollars
21 (\$500.00), or imprisoned in the county jail for not more than one
22 (1) year, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Any person
23 convicted of a second or subsequent violation shall be guilty of a
24 felony, and shall be fined not less than Two Thousand Five Hundred
25 Dollars (\$2,500.00) nor more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00),

1 or imprisoned in the State Penitentiary for not more than five (5)
2 years, or by both such fine and imprisonment. The ABLE Commission
3 shall revoke the license of any person convicted of a violation of
4 this section.

5 B. Any person convicted of a violation pursuant to subsection A
6 of this section shall be required to attend a victim impact panel
7 program, as defined in Section 991a of Title 22 of the Oklahoma
8 Statutes.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
