AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to unauthorized practice of law; defining term; prohibiting unauthorized practice of law; creating misdemeanor offense; establishing punishment; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

- A new section of law to be codified SECTION 1. NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1.1A of Title 5, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- For purposes of this section, "unauthorized practice of law" Α. occurs when a person solicits or accepts compensation for giving legal advice of any kind or acting on behalf of a client in any judicial or administrative proceeding without being licensed to practice law in this state. This shall include, but not be limited to, appearing before a court on behalf of a client or preparing and causing a document to be presented to a court on behalf of a client.
- Any person who engages in the unauthorized practice of law В. shall be guilty of a misdemeanor that, upon conviction, shall be
