6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the State Capitol and Capitol
8 Building; requiring organized protests groups of
9 certain size to post bond with Oklahoma Capitol
Improvement Authority; providing for codification;
and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 65 of Title 73, unless there is
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Any organization or group of one hundred or more persons that
17 engages in an organized protest at the State Capitol building shall
18 be required to post a bond of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00)
19 with the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority in order to offset
20 the cost of additional security, clean up and repairs.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
