7 An Act relating to hospital facilities; requiring
8 hospitals to provide certain information to the State
9 Department of Health by certain date; directing the
10 Department to create and maintain certain database;
11 requiring public access; requiring hospitals to
12 provide certain notice; directing certain database
13 updates; directing hospitals to provide certain
14 information to patients upon admission; providing
15 definition; providing for codification; and providing
16 an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-711a of Title 63, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. Within thirty (30) calendar days of the effective date of
22 this act, every hospital in this state that performs any type of
23 surgical procedures shall provide information to the State
24 Department of Health regarding any surgical procedures that the
25 hospital does not perform on weekends.

1 B. The Department shall create and maintain a database
2 containing this information on its website. The database shall be
3 easily accessible by the public.

4 C. Each hospital shall be responsible for notifying the
5 Department regarding changes to its surgical schedules as soon as
6 possible. The Department shall update the database as necessary.

7 D. Every hospital shall provide information regarding the
8 website to all patients upon admission to the hospital.

9 E. For purposes of this section, "hospital" shall have the same
10 meaning as provided in Section 1-701 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma
11 Statutes.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.

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
