as provided in subsection C of this section, for"

16 AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 2, line 7, insert, after the word "family"
17 and before the period ".", the words ", provided
at least fifty percent (50%) of the owners of the
18 entity shall be residents of this state to qualify
for the exemption"

19 AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 2, line 15 1/2, insert a new subsection C as
20 follows:. "C. Animals owned wholly or in part by
a publicly traded corporation or a corporation
21 incorporated in a state other than this state
shall not qualify for the exemption authorized
22 pursuant to subsection B of Section 6 of Article X
of the Oklahoma Constitution as livestock employed
23 in support of the family."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2011, Section 2807.1, as
14 amended by Section 1, Chapter 193, O.S.L. 2012 (68 O.S. Supp. 2020,
15 Section 2807.1), is amended to read as follows:

16 Section 2807.1 A. For purposes of the exemption authorized
17 pursuant to subsection ~~(b)~~ B of Section 6 of Article X of the
18 Oklahoma Constitution, "livestock employed in support of the family"
19 means all horses, cattle, mules, asses, sheep, swine, goats, poultry
20 and any other livestock.

21 B. For purposes of the exemption authorized pursuant to
22 subsection ~~(b)~~ B of Section 6 of Article X of the Oklahoma
23 Constitution, and for purposes of this section, livestock owned by a
24 general partnership, limited partnership, corporation, limited

1 liability company, estate, trust or other lawfully recognized entity
2 ~~the primary purpose of which is to confer the economic benefits~~
3 ~~derived from the ownership of the livestock on two or more members~~
4 ~~of the same family and not any persons who are not members of the~~
5 ~~same family, whether such members are related by consanguinity or~~
6 ~~affinity,~~ shall be deemed to be livestock employed in support of the
7 family. ~~For purposes of this subsection, an adopted child shall be~~
8 ~~treated as being related by consanguinity to the person or persons~~
9 ~~who become the adoptive parent or parents of such child.~~

10 ~~C. For purposes of the exempt treatment provided by subsection~~
11 ~~B of this section, a surviving spouse having no other family members~~
12 ~~by consanguinity or affinity after the death of his or her spouse~~
13 ~~shall continue to be eligible for the exempt treatment of livestock~~
14 ~~used for his or her support according to the requirements of~~
15 ~~subsection B of this section.~~

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
