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2 BILL NO. 2974

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11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-120.11 of Title 26, unless  
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. No later than June 1 of each year, the State Election Board  
16 shall perform a query of the entire voter registration database to  
17 determine how many individuals are registered at the same  
18 residential address.

19 B. If more than ten registered voters share a single  
20 residential address, the State Election Board shall provide a list  
21 of said voters to the secretary of the county election board, who  
22 shall immediately notify the district attorney for that county.

23 C. Upon receipt of such notification, the district attorney, or  
24 a member of law enforcement designated by the district attorney,

1 shall investigate any possible criminal violation of the law related  
2 to the voter registration.

3 D. Provided, this section shall not apply to registered voters  
4 sharing a residential address at a nursing home, veterans center,  
5 medical facility, multiunit housing, installations of the Armed  
6 Forces of the United States where uniformed or overseas voters, as  
7 defined by the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act,  
8 are stationed, or other locations authorized in writing by the  
9 Secretary of the State Election Board.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
