David Arthur Peters Memorial Highway; designating the
Ray Davis Memorial Intersection; designating the
Robert L. Horton Memorial Highway; designating the
John L. Hayden Memorial Highway; designating the
Creede Speake Jr. Memorial Highway; designating the
W.D. Bill Amis Memorial Bridge; designating the SSG
Michael R. Robson Memorial Highway; designating the
Carolyn Woods Memorial Bridge; designating the Martin
Dyer Memorial Highway; amending Section 11, Chapter

1 369, O.S.L. 2019 (69 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section
2 1698.296), which relates to the Councilwoman Avalon
3 Reese Memorial Highway; modifying name of certain
4 memorial highway; providing for codification; and
5 providing an effective date.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

7 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.308 of Title 69, unless
9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 The bridge over Elk Creek on State Highway 9 located
11 approximately one (1) mile west of Hobart in Kiowa County shall be
12 designated as the "WWII Doolittle Raider - Bombardier Sgt. Robert
13 James "R.J." Stephens Memorial Bridge". The Department of
14 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
15 name to be placed on the bridge.

16 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.309 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The bridge over Flat Creek on State Highway 34 located
20 approximately one-half (0.5) mile north of West Madison Avenue near
21 the town of Carter in Beckham County shall be designated as the
22 "U.S. Army PFC Keith N. Cantrell Memorial Bridge". The Department
23 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing
24 that name to be placed on the bridge.

1 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.310 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of State Highway 82 beginning at the intersection of
5 U.S. Highway 62 and extending southeasterly to the intersection of
6 East Flournory Road south of Tahlequah in Cherokee County shall be
7 designated as the "Paul Blevins, Jr., and Michael Rogers Memorial
8 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
9 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

10 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.311 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The bridge over Muddy Boggy Creek on State Highway 43 located
14 approximately one (1) mile east of the town of Coalgate in Coal
15 County shall be designated as the "Stiles Brothers Vietnam Veteran
16 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
17 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
18 bridge.

19 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.312 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The section of U.S. Highway 69 in Ottawa County beginning at the
23 intersection of Newman Road then extending north to the intersection
24 of Commerce Street in the City of Commerce shall be designated as

1 "South Mickey Mantle Boulevard". The Department of Transportation
2 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
3 placed on the highway.

4 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.313 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The section of State Highway 18 beginning at Deep Rock Road and
8 extending north three (3) miles in Payne County shall be designated
9 as the "Terry L. Hoggatt Memorial Highway". The Department of
10 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
11 name to be placed on the highway.

12 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.314 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the bridge over
16 South 129th Avenue on State Highway 51, also known as the Broken
17 Arrow Expressway, in Broken Arrow, Tulsa County, shall be designated
18 as the "Jennifer McClendon Memorial Bridge". The Department of
19 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
20 name to be placed on the bridge.

21 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.315 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24

1 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the bridge over Lee
2 Boulevard on Interstate 44 in the City of Lawton in Comanche County
3 shall be designated as the "Maj. Charles E. Stiles Memorial Bridge".
4 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
5 markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

6 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.316 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the section of State
10 Highway 28A beginning at the intersection of State Highway 66 near
11 the Town of Foyil extending east to the intersection of Interstate
12 44 in Rogers County shall be designated as the "CSM Junior H.
13 Honeycutt Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
14 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
15 the highway.

16 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.317 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The bridge crossing over the Washita River on U.S. Highway 62
20 located three-tenths (0.3) of a mile east of the H.E. Bailey
21 Turnpike near Chickasha in Grady County shall be designated as the
22 "Ada Lois Sipuel Fisher Memorial Bridge". The Department of
23 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
24 name to be placed on the bridge.

1 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.318 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the bridge crossing
5 over the Washita River on State Highway 8 north of the city of
6 Anadarko in Caddo County shall be designated as the "Joe W. McBride
7 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
8 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
9 bridge.

10 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.319 of Title 69, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The section of the U.S. Highway 70 Bypass beginning just south
14 of U.S. 70 and extending south and west to the intersection of
15 McLean Drive on the west side of the city of Durant in Bryan County
16 shall be designated as the "Deputy Jarid Taylor Memorial Highway".
17 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
18 markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

19 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.320 of Title 69, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The section of State Highway 78 beginning just north of the
23 intersection of State Highway 22 extending northwesterly to the
24 eastern municipal limits of Milburn in Johnston County shall be

1 designated as the "USAF Capt. Nick Karpis Vietnam Veteran Memorial
2 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
3 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

4 SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.321 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The section of State Highway 7 beginning at the north municipal
8 limits of Mill Creek in Johnston County then extending northerly to
9 the Murray County line shall be designated as the "Sgt. Clyde Runyan
10 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
11 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
12 highway.

13 SECTION 15. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.322 of Title 69, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The causeway over Old Spiro Lake on State Highway 9 in LeFlore
17 County shall be designated as the "Sgt. Maj. Marvail Lewis Memorial
18 Causeway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
19 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the causeway.

20 SECTION 16. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.323 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The section of U.S. Highway 64 beginning at the intersection of
24 E1040 Road extending northerly to the intersection of E. 128th

1 Street in Muskogee County shall be designated as the "County
2 Commissioner Roy Rains Memorial Highway". The Department of
3 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
4 name to be placed on the highway.

5 SECTION 17. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.324 of Title 69, unless
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 The section of State Highway 20 beginning at the intersection of
9 U.S. Highway 75 extending east two (2) miles to the intersection of
10 N. Memorial Road in Tulsa County shall be designated as the "PFC
11 Richard Tafoya Gurule Memorial Highway". The Department of
12 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
13 name to be placed on the highway.

14 SECTION 18. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.325 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The section of State Highway 9 beginning at the intersection of
18 Interstate 35 extending west to the intersection of U.S. Highway 62
19 in McClain County shall be designated as the "Capt. David Arthur
20 Peters Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
21 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
22 the highway.

1 SECTION 19. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.326 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
4 The intersection of State Highway 66 and Banner Road in Canadian
5 County shall be designated as the Ray Davis Memorial Intersection.
6 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
7 markers bearing that name to be placed at the intersection.

8 SECTION 20. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
9 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.327 of Title 69, unless
10 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

11 The section of State Highway 25 beginning at the intersection of
12 State Highway 2 extending east to the western municipal limits of
13 Bluejacket in Craig County shall be known as the "Robert L. Horton
14 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
15 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
16 highway.

17 SECTION 21. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.328 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The section of State Highway 3 West beginning at the west side
21 of the State Highway 19 interchange extending west to the
22 intersection of County Road 1510 in Pontotoc County shall be known
23 as the "John L. Hayden Memorial Highway". The Department of
24

1 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
2 name to be placed on the highway.

3 SECTION 22. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.329 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the section of State
7 Highway 53 beginning at the intersection of Midway Road extending
8 east through the community of Milo to the intersection of Woodford
9 Road in Carter County shall be known as the "Creede Speake Jr.
10 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
11 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
12 highway.

13 SECTION 23. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.330 of Title 69, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The bridge over Honey Creek Pass located on Interstate 35 just
17 south of Exit 51 in Murray County shall be known as the "W.D. Bill
18 Amis Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
19 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
20 bridge.

21 SECTION 24. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.331 of Title 69, unless
23 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24

1 The section of State Highway 199 from the western municipal
2 limits of Dickson to the eastern municipal limits of Ardmore shall
3 be known as the "SSG Michael R. Robson Memorial Highway". The
4 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
5 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

6 SECTION 25. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.332 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The bridge crossing over US Highway 69 Business located on US
10 Highway 69 at the south edge of McAlester in Pittsburg County shall
11 be known as the "Carolyn Woods Memorial Bridge". The Department of
12 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
13 name to be placed on the bridge.

14 SECTION 26. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.333 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the section of U.S.
18 Highway 77 beginning at the intersection of Broadway Avenue in
19 Ardmore extending north to the intersection of State Highway 142 in
20 Carter County shall be known as the "Martin Dyer Memorial Highway".
21 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable markers
22 bearing that name to the placed on the highway.

1 SECTION 27. AMENDATORY Section 11, Chapter 369, O.S.L.
2 2019 (69 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 1698.296), is amended to read as
3 follows:

4 Section 1698.296 The section of U.S. Highway 64 Business
5 beginning at West 23rd Street South extending north to the
6 intersection of West Southside Blvd. in the City of Muskogee in
7 Muskogee County shall be designated as the "Councilwoman Avalon
8 ~~Reese~~ Reece Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
9 shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be
10 placed on the highway.

11 SECTION 28. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
