14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:													
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 40 O.S. 2021, Section 1-221, is													
16	amended to read as follows:													
17	Section 1-221. BENEFIT WAGES.													
18	"Benefit wages" means the taxable wages earned by a claimant													
19	during the claimant's base period which are not in excess of the													
20	current maximum weekly benefit amount, as determined under Section													
21	2-104 of this title, multiplied by the maximum number of weeks for													
22	which benefits could be paid to any individual (now twenty-six (26)													
23	weeks) pursuant to Section 3 of this act multiplied by three (3);													
24	provided, however, no wages shall be included as "benefit wages"

unless and until the claimant has been paid benefits for five (5)
 weeks in one (1) benefit year.

3SECTION 2.AMENDATORY40 O.S. 2021, Section 2-4106, is amended to read as follows:

5 Section 2-106. MAXIMUM BENEFIT AMOUNT.

An Effective January 1, 2023, an otherwise eligible individual
shall be entitled during any benefit year to a total amount of
benefits equal to whichever is the lesser of:

9 1. Twenty-six (26) times the weekly benefit amount of the10 individual;

11 The applicable percentage of the state's average annual wage 2. 12 for the second preceding calendar year as determined by the 13 Commission, rounded to the nearest multiple of One Hundred Dollars 14 (\$100.00). The applicable percentage is determined by the 15 conditional factor in place during the calendar year in which the 16 individual files for benefits. The conditional factor is determined 17 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3-113 of this title. The 18 applicable percentages for this paragraph are as follows:

19a.twenty-five percent (25%) during any calendar year in20which the balance in the Unemployment Compensation21Fund is in excess of the amount required to initiate22conditional contribution rates, pursuant to the23provisions of Section 3-113 of this title,

1 b. twenty-three and three-fourths percent (23.75%) during 2 calendar years in which condition "a" exists, twenty-two and one-half percent (22.5%) during 3 с. calendar years in which condition "b" exists, 4 5 d. twenty-one and one-fourth percent (21.25%) during calendar years in which condition "c" exists, and 6 7 twenty percent (20%) during calendar years in which e. condition "d" exists; or 8

9 3. The applicable percentage of the individual's wages for 10 insured work paid during the base period of the individual. The 11 applicable percentage is determined by the conditional factor in 12 place during the calendar year in which the individual files for 13 benefits. The conditional factor is determined pursuant to the 14 provisions of Section 3-113 of this title. The applicable 15 percentages for this paragraph are as follows:

16 fifty percent (50%) during any calendar year in which а. 17 the balance in the Unemployment Compensation Fund is 18 in excess of the amount required to initiate 19 conditional contribution rates, pursuant to the 20 provisions of Section 3-113 of this title, 21 b. forty-seven and one-half percent (47.5%) during 22 calendar years in which condition "a" exists, 23 forty-five percent (45%) during calendar years in с. 24 which condition "b" exists,

- 1d. forty-two and one-half percent (42.5%) during calendar2years in which condition "c" exists, and
- 3 e. forty percent (40%) during calendar years in which
  4 condition "d" exists.

5 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-230 of Title 40, unless there 7 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 For purposes of this section, "state average unemployment rate" 9 means the average of the three (3) months for the most recent third 10 calendar year quarter or the seasonally adjusted unemployment rates 11 as published by the Office of Unemployment Insurance within the U.S. 12 Department of Labor's Employment and Training Administration or the 13 agency responsible for collecting and publishing unemployment rate 14 data.

15 For unemployment compensation claims submitted during a calendar 16 year, the duration of benefits is limited to:

17 1. Twelve (12) weeks if the state's average unemployment rate 18 is at or below three percent (3%);

19 2. An additional week may be added in addition to the twelve 20 (12) weeks for each one-half percent (0.5%) increment in the state's 21 average unemployment rate above three percent (3%); or

22 3. Up to a maximum of twenty (20) weeks.
