9 An Act relating to revenue and taxation; creating
10 exemption from motor vehicle excise tax for veterans
11 and active duty military; requiring refund of tax
12 collected; providing for codification; and providing
13 an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2105.1 of Title 68, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Any transfer of legal ownership of a vehicle to any person
19 who has been honorably or medically discharged from active service
20 in any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States or Oklahoma
21 National Guard and registered with the veterans registry created by
22 the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs or any person who is
23 currently serving on active duty in the Armed Forces of the United
24 States who can show valid military identification who is currently

1 stationed or maintains a permanent residence in the State of
2 Oklahoma shall be exempt from the excise tax levied by Section 2103
3 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

4 B. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall issue a refund to the
5 buyer of excise tax collected by a dealer under Section 2103 of
6 Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes from any person who qualifies for
7 the exemption under this section. If the purchase of the vehicle
8 was made with a loan, the refund shall be issued to the lienholder.
9 The lienholder shall deduct the refund amount from the balance due
10 on the loan.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2022.
