For purposes of the exemption authorized pursuant to 2 subsection (b) B of Section 6 of Article X of the Oklahoma Constitution, and for purposes of this section, livestock owned by a 3 general partnership, limited partnership, corporation, limited 4 liability company, estate, trust or other lawfully recognized entity 5 6 the primary purpose of which is to confer the economic benefits 7 derived from the ownership of the livestock on two or more members of the same family and not any persons who are not members of the 8 9 same family, whether such members are related by consanguinity or 10 affinity, shall be deemed to be livestock employed in support of the 11 family. For purposes of this subsection, an adopted child shall be 12 treated as being related by consanguinity to the person or persons 13 who become the adoptive parent or parents of such child. 14 C. For purposes of the exempt treatment provided by subsection 15 B of this section, a surviving spouse having no other family members 16 by consanguinity or affinity after the death of his or her spouse 17 shall continue to be eligible for the exempt treatment of livestock 18 used for his or her support according to the requirements of 19 subsection B of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.

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
