7 PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

8 An Act relating to alcoholic beverages; providing
9 that a holder of a small farm winery or winemaker
10 license may serve free samples and sell other items;
11 providing wine may be served at off-premises
12 locations; providing that at public events the
13 location occupied by the small farm winery or
14 winemaker licensee becomes a licensed premises and
15 extension of the licensed small farm winery or
16 winemaker; requiring a licensee to establish a
17 serving area; providing that multiple licensees may
18 combine their serving areas; providing for
19 codification; and providing an effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-162 of Title 37A, unless there
23 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 A holder of a small farm winery or winemaker license, which
serves wine for on-premises or off-premises consumption, shall be
allowed to serve free samples, or sell Oklahoma-manufactured wine,
mulled wine, or spiced wine, mixed with nonalcoholic beverages, or
food items such as water, sugar, fruits, and vegetables, at any

1 temperature. Wine produced by a holder of a small farm winery or
2 winemaker license may be served at any public events including, but
3 not limited to, festivals, trade shows, boat shows, RV shows, home
4 and garden shows, fairs, car shows, swap meets, city events, county
5 events, or state events for either on-premises or off-premises
6 consumption. This includes any public events that are held at
7 premises which hold a retail beer license, retail spirits license,
8 mixed beverage license, beer and wine license, caterer's license,
9 special event license, public event license, winemaker license,
10 charitable auction license, or brewpub license. At public events,
11 the location within the event occupied by the small farm winery or
12 winemaker licensee becomes a licensed premises and extension of the
13 licensed small farm winery or winemaker. The licensee shall set up
14 and define an area contiguous to its booth space as a serving area
15 where the wine is dispensed. The licensee may only serve the wine
16 in the serving area. In the event that multiple winemakers are at
17 the same public event, they may combine their serving areas into one
18 larger area as long as they are contiguous to the winemakers'
19 booths.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
