20	required to offer exemptions from the mandatory vaccination

22	1. An individual having a moral or religious tenet which
23	opposes vaccination; or

1 2. A written statement by a licensed physician stating the 2 physical condition of the individual is such that a vaccine would 3 endanger the life or health of the individual. There shall be no justification evidence needed to be 4 в. 5 granted a moral or religious tenet exemption. 6 C. Where an employee is under eighteen (18) years of age, the 7 employee shall not be required to receive any vaccinations without 8 the written permission of a parent or guardian. 9 SECTION 2.
