15 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana
16 Authority; creating County Sheriff Public Safety
17 Grant Revolving Fund; providing sources of funds;
18 providing for use of funds; prescribing procedures
19 for expenditures; stipulating local law enforcement
20 programs; providing for codification; providing an
21 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
24 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 427.3A of Title 63, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
for the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority to be designated the
"County Sheriff Public Safety Grant Revolving Fund". The fund shall
be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and

1 shall consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Medical
2 Marijuana Authority that are appropriated or apportioned to this
3 fund, and any federal funds, grants, and donations from any public
4 or private source for the purpose of supporting county sheriffs.
5 All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
6 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma
7 Medical Marijuana Authority for the purpose of establishing programs
8 and providing funding to support county sheriffs to enforce the
9 requirements of state law with respect to the commercial growth of
10 medical marijuana or other related business activity for which a
11 license is required pursuant to the provisions of law governing the
12 production, cultivation, transportation, distribution, sale, or
13 other actions related to medical marijuana. Expenditures from the
14 fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer
15 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the
16 Office of Management and Enterprise Services for approval and
17 payment.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022.

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
