17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be				
18	codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:				
19	From the Statewide Recovery Fund created pursuant to Enrolled				
20	House Bill 3349 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature,				
21	the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) shall be appropriated

NEW LAW A new section of law not to be 6 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows: 7 From the Statewide Recovery Fund created pursuant to Enrolled 8 House Bill 3349 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, 9 the sum of Three Hundred Sixty-five Thousand Sixty-eight Dollars 10 (\$365,068.00) shall be appropriated to the Oklahoma Broadband 11 Governing Board created pursuant to Enrolled House Bill 3363 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature.
