L 4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
L5	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 2804, is
L 6	amended to read as follows:
L7	Section 2804. <u>A.</u> Every system may include police, fire
18	fighting and emergency medical and ambulance services, and may
L 9	include other emergency services, in the discretion of the affected
20	public agency, such as poison control services, suicide prevention
21	services and emergency <del>management</del> services. The system may
22	incorporate a private ambulance service. In those areas in which a
23	public safety agency of the state provides such emergency services,
24	the system may include such public safety agencies.

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        B. In those areas in which a volunteer fire department serves a
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    nine-one-one (911) emergency telephone area:
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        1. All emergency calls received through the nine-one-one (911)
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    system; and
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        2. All calls requesting emergency management services,
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    shall be dispatched to the volunteer fire department of the nearest
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    geographic proximity to the call location.
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        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
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
