8 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 An Act relating to motorcycles; amending 47 O.S.
10 2021, Section 11-1103, which relates to motorcycles;
11 deleting certain passing restriction; and providing
12 an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 11-1103, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 11-1103. A. No person under the age of sixteen (16)
17 years shall drive a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, motorized
18 scooter, or motorized bicycle on any highway of this state while
19 transporting any other person.

20 B. The operator of a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, motorized
21 scooter, or motorized bicycle who has attained the age of sixteen
22 (16) years or older may carry a passenger if the vehicle has a wheel
23 diameter of twelve (12) inches or greater and is factory-designed
24 and equipped with either:

1 1. A double seating device with double foot rests; or

2 2. A sidecar attachment providing a separate seat space within
3 such sidecar attachment for each person riding therein so that such
4 person shall be seated entirely within the body of said sidecar.

5 C. No rider of a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, motorized
6 scooter, or motorized bicycle shall hold to any moving vehicle for
7 the purpose of being propelled.

8 ~~D. No driver of a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, motorized~~
9 ~~scooter, motorized bicycle, or electric-assisted bicycle shall pass~~
10 ~~other vehicles between lanes of traffic traveling in the same~~
11 ~~direction. This subsection shall not apply to the operator of an~~
12 ~~authorized emergency vehicle.~~

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
