8 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9 An Act relating to public health; amending 63 O.S.
10 2021, Section 1-229.35, which relates to vapor
11 manufacturers reporting; changing compliance
12 deadline; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 1-229.35, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 1-229.35 A. Beginning July 1, ~~2022~~ 2023, every
17 manufacturer of a vapor product that is sold or intended to be sold
18 in this state, whether directly or through a distributor, retailer,
19 or similar intermediary or intermediaries, shall execute and deliver
20 an attestation under penalty of perjury to the Oklahoma Alcoholic
21 Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission certifying that, as of
22 the date of such attestation:

23 1. The vapor product was available for purchase in the United
24 States as of August 8, 2016, and the manufacturer has applied for a

1 marketing order for the vapor product by submitting a Premarket
2 Tobacco Product Application on or before September 9, 2020, to the
3 United States Food and Drug Administration (FDA); or

4 2. The manufacturer has received a marketing order or other
5 authorization for the vapor product from the FDA pursuant to Section
6 387j of Title 21 of the United States Code.

7 B. The manufacturer shall notify the ABLE Commission within
8 thirty (30) days of any material change to the attestation,
9 including whether the FDA has issued or not issued a market order or
10 other authorization or has ordered the manufacturer to remove the
11 vapor product, either temporarily or permanently, from the United
12 States market.

13 C. The ABLE Commission shall develop a directory listing all of
14 the manufacturers that have provided attestations that comply with
15 subsection A of this section and all vapor products that are listed
16 in such attestations. The ABLE Commission shall:

17 1. Make the directory available for public inspection on its
18 website on or before October 1, ~~2022~~ 2023; and

19 2. Update the directory as necessary to correct mistakes and to
20 add or remove manufacturers or vapor products to maintain the
21 directory in conformity with the requirements of this section.

22 D. It shall be unlawful for any person, directly or indirectly,
23 to knowingly manufacture, distribute, sell, barter, or furnish in
24 this state any vapor product that is not included in the directory.

1 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
