10 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;  
12 authorizing certain expenditures for certain  
13 purposes; authorizing the Department of Public Safety  
14 to hold additional trooper academies subject to  
15 available funding; authorizing use of certain  
16 revolving fund; providing lapse dates; and requiring  
17 and prohibiting certain budget procedures.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Department of  
20 Public Safety in Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st Session of  
21 the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Public Safety is  
22 hereby authorized to expend Four Hundred Thirty-nine Thousand One  
23 Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$439,120.00) for any necessary expenditures  
24 related to interoperable communications inside the State Capitol  
Building.

1 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Department of  
2 Public Safety in Enrolled House Bill No. 2900 of the 1st Session of  
3 the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the Department of Public Safety is  
4 hereby authorized to expend Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) to  
5 hold a trooper academy. Subject to available funding, the  
6 Department is authorized to hold additional academies.

7 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the  
8 Department of Public Safety is hereby authorized to utilize the  
9 Department of Public Safety Restricted Revolving Fund (245 Fund), as  
10 may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department  
11 of Public Safety by law.

12 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
13 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
14 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022 (hereafter FY-22), or may be  
15 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23).  
16 Funds budgeted for FY-22 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
17 2022, and must be expended by November 15, 2022. Any funds  
18 remaining after November 15, 2022, and not budgeted for FY-23, shall  
19 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
20 year. Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June  
21 30, 2023. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2023, shall lapse  
22 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
23 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
24 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-22, and not required to pay

1 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-23, after  
2 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
3 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
4 from the FY-22 budget work program and after such revision has been  
5 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

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
