9 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to energy; creating the Oklahoma
11 Consumer Energy Choice Act; providing short title;
12 defining term; prohibiting certain entities from
13 adopting certain policies that limit consumer access
14 to certain energy sources; prohibiting certain
15 limitations by political subdivisions; providing for
16 codification; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5171 of Title 74, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma
22 Consumer Energy Choice Act".

23 B. For the purposes of this act, "energy source" means any fuel
24 or power source used to power an engine including but not limited to
any of the following: aviation fuel, biofuel, compressed natural

1 gas, diesel, electricity to be utilized for the charging of electric
2 vehicles, gasoline, gas distillates, hydrogen, liquified petroleum
3 gas, and renewable diesel.

4 C. No city, town, county, or subdivision thereof shall adopt an
5 ordinance, rule, or code which limits consumer access to an energy
6 source or that results in the de facto prohibition of a wholesaler,
7 retailer, energy producer, or the related infrastructure that is
8 necessary to provide consumer access to a specific energy source
9 within the jurisdiction of a city, town, county, or subdivision
10 thereof.

11 D. For the purposes of promoting commerce and the equitable
12 treatment of the citizens of this state, limitations of consumer
13 access to an energy source by any city, town, county, or subdivision
14 thereof is declared to be a statewide concern and shall be
15 prohibited pursuant to subsection C of this section.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
