10 An Act relating to inmate education; authorizing the  
11 expansion of certain inmate education programs;  
12 providing for codification; and providing an  
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 568 of Title 57, unless there is  
17 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The Department of Corrections may establish a Hospice Care and  
19 Certified Nurse Assistant training program administered through the  
20 Health Services Division under the direction of the Chief Medical  
21 Officer. The program shall be designed to provide inmate education,  
22 training, and clinical experience to adequately prepare the  
23 participants for related career opportunities upon release from  
24 incarceration.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
