18	Fund of the State Treasury created in Enrolled House Bill No. 3349			
19	of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of			
20	Fifteen Million Dollars (\$15,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may			
21	be necessary to establish a grant program with Northeastern State			
22	University for the purpose of recruiting, educating, and stabilizing
