12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
14	Juvenile Affairs in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session
15	of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Two Million Five
16	Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00) shall be used to update the
17	Children's Emergency Resource Center rates.
18	SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
19	Juvenile Affairs in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session
20	of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty
21	Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) shall be used for the purchase of
22	vocational equipment.
23	SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
24	Juvenile Affairs in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session

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of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred Fifty
 Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall be used for the hiring of two
 workforce development specialists.

SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
Juvenile Affairs in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session
of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million Nine
Hundred Fifty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$1,957,000.00) shall be used
for program development and enhancements.

9 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
10 Juvenile Affairs in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session
11 of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million Seven
12 Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$1,715,000.00) shall be used to
13 increase funding for the transitional community housing and
14 independent program.

SECTION 6. Appropriations made by Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 15 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, not including 16 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for 17 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23) or may be 18 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24). 19 Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 30, 20 2023, and must be expended by November 15, 2023. Any funds 21 remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for FY-24, shall 22 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal 23 Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June 24 year.

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1 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2024, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. 2 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years 3 simultaneously.
