7 An Act relating to the Office of Juvenile Affairs;
8 requiring that certain appropriated funds be used for
9 certain purpose; requiring certain funds be used to
10 supplement and not replace existing funding;
11 providing for lapse of funds under certain
12 conditions; requiring certain budget procedures; and
13 prohibiting certain budget procedures.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
16 Juvenile Affairs in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session
17 of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Two Million Five
18 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,500,000.00) shall be used to update the
19 Children's Emergency Resource Center rates.

20 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
21 Juvenile Affairs in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session
22 of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty
23 Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) shall be used for the purchase of
24 vocational equipment.

SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
Juvenile Affairs in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session

1 of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Hundred Fifty
2 Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall be used for the hiring of two
3 workforce development specialists.

4 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
5 Juvenile Affairs in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session
6 of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million Nine
7 Hundred Fifty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$1,957,000.00) shall be used
8 for program development and enhancements.

9 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
10 Juvenile Affairs in Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040 of the 2nd Session
11 of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million Seven
12 Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$1,715,000.00) shall be used to
13 increase funding for the transitional community housing and
14 independent program.

15 SECTION 6. Appropriations made by Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1040
16 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, not including
17 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
18 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23) or may be
19 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24).
20 Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 30,
21 2023, and must be expended by November 15, 2023. Any funds
22 remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for FY-24, shall
23 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
24 year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June

1 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2024, shall lapse
2 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
3 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
4 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23, and not required to pay
5 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-24, after
6 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
7 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
8 from the FY-23 budget work program and after such revision has been
9 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
