NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-181.2 of Title 2, unless there 16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 17 The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry 18 shall review methods of remote viewing or other digital inspection 19 technology for meat and poultry product inspections. 20 If the Department determines a suitable method of remote 21 viewing or other digital inspection technology upon completion of 22 the review, then the Department shall make application to the 23

federal agency governing meat and poultry inspection to request use of the technology.

- C. Upon approval by the federal agency governing meat and poultry inspection, the Department shall promulgate rules to implement the use of remote viewing or other digital inspection technology.
- D. The use of remote viewing or other digital inspection technology shall be restricted to inspections of meat and poultry products sold only in intrastate commerce, unless the federal agency governing meat and poultry inspection approves it for interstate commerce.
- E. The videos from remote viewing or digital inspection obtained pursuant to this section shall be kept confidential by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
