7 An Act relating to meat inspections; authorizing the
8 Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
9 Forestry to review methods of remote viewing or other
10 digital inspection; requiring the Department to apply
11 for use of inspection technology from the applicable
12 federal agency; providing for promulgation of rules;
13 limiting remote inspections to intrastate commerce
14 unless otherwise approved; requiring the Department
15 to keep videos confidential; providing for
16 codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-181.2 of Title 2, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry
shall review methods of remote viewing or other digital inspection
technology for meat and poultry product inspections.

B. If the Department determines a suitable method of remote
viewing or other digital inspection technology upon completion of
the review, then the Department shall make application to the

1 federal agency governing meat and poultry inspection to request use
2 of the technology.

3 C. Upon approval by the federal agency governing meat and
4 poultry inspection, the Department shall promulgate rules to
5 implement the use of remote viewing or other digital inspection
6 technology.

7 D. The use of remote viewing or other digital inspection
8 technology shall be restricted to inspections of meat and poultry
9 products sold only in intrastate commerce, unless the federal agency
10 governing meat and poultry inspection approves it for interstate
11 commerce.

12 E. The videos from remote viewing or digital inspection
13 obtained pursuant to this section shall be kept confidential by the
14 Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
