6	An Act relating to driver licenses; amending 47 O.S. 2021, Section 6-124, which relates to veterans
7	designation on licenses; requiring Department of Public Safety to include certain identifications to
8	indicate certain disability rating and status;
9	authorizing certain persons to receive license or identification indicating certain status; authorizing
10	certain status to be valid for confirmation of veterans benefits to certain entities; requiring
11	certain registration; requiring certain departments to implement technology to validate certain claims by
12	a certain date; and declaring an emergency.
13	
14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 6-124, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	Section 6-124. A. As a way to honor and recognize the veterans
18	who have served our country, the Department of Public Safety shall
19	make space available in the upper left-hand corner of the front of
20	the driver license and the identification card for a flag emblem and
21	the word "veteran". When applicable, the Department of Public
22	Safety shall, on the front or back of the driver license or the
23	identification card, include a numeric designation indicating a
24	veteran's one hundred percent (100%) disability rating granted to

1 the veteran by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs. The items required by this subsection shall to be designed by the 2 Department of Public Safety that will and shall serve as a notation 3 of veteran status and as a notation of the existence of a United 4 5 States Department of Veterans Affairs disability rating as applicable. The current spouse of a one-hundred-percent disabled 6 veteran or a surviving spouse of a deceased, one-hundred-percent 7 disabled veteran, who has not remarried, shall be entitled to 8 9 receive a driver license or identification card indicating his or 10 her status as an eligible current spouse or an eligible surviving 11 spouse who has not remarried entitled to the sales tax exemption 12 provided in Section 1357 of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Representation of veteran status and disability rating on the driver 13 license and the identification card shall be adequate confirmation 14 for purposes of veterans benefits offered by public or private 15 entities doing business within this state and no further 16 documentation shall be required except as specifically mandated by 17 federal law. 18 B. Upon application for issuance or renewal of the driver 19 license or identification card and in addition to other 20 documentation required by the Department, persons requesting the 21

flag emblem <u>or the flag emblem and disability notation</u> shall be registered with the <del>veterans registry</del> <u>Oklahoma Veterans Registry</u> created by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Provided,

1 that if the person requesting the flag emblem has previously 2 received a flag emblem pursuant to this subsection, no registration 3 with the veterans registry shall be required to receive the flag 4 emblem prior to the deadline established in subsection C of this 5 section.

C. The Department of Public Safety and the Oklahoma Department 6 of Veterans Affairs shall implement a technology-based information 7 exchange process where the Department of Public Safety and all motor 8 9 license agents are able to validate, upon application for issuance 10 or renewal of the driver license or identification card, an 11 applicant's claim of veteran status, veteran disability status, 12 status as a current spouse of an eligible disabled veteran, or status as an eligible surviving spouse of an eligible deceased 13 disabled veteran as provided for in subsection A of this section. 14 The requirements of this subsection shall be implemented no later 15 than July 1, 2023. 16

17 <u>D.</u> The Department of Public Safety shall promulgate any rule
18 necessary to implement the provisions of this section.

19 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 20 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
