6 An Act relating to students; requiring school  
7 districts and charter schools to include certain  
8 information on student identification cards; allowing  
9 certain information to be included on student  
10 identification cards; stating legislative intent that  
11 certain institutions of higher education include  
12 certain information on student identification cards;  
13 allowing issuance of certain non-compliant  
14 identification cards until a supply is depleted;  
15 providing for application; providing for  
16 codification; and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-100.10 of Title 70, unless  
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. Beginning July 1, 2023, school districts and charter schools  
22 that serve any students in grades seven through twelve and issue  
23 student identification cards shall have printed on either side of  
24 the student identification cards the telephone number described in  
paragraph 1 of this subsection and may have printed on either side  
of the student identification cards the telephone number described  
in paragraph 2 of this subsection:

1        1. The National Suicide Prevention Lifeline, which can be  
2 accessed by calling or texting 988; and

3        2. The Crisis Text Line, which can be accessed by texting HOME  
4 to 741741.

5        B. It is the intent of the Legislature that beginning July 1,  
6 2023, institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher  
7 Education and private institutions of higher education in the state  
8 that issue student identification cards may print on either side of  
9 the student identification cards the telephone numbers described in  
10 paragraphs 1, 2, and 3 of this subsection:

11        1. The National Suicide Prevention Lifeline, which can be  
12 accessed by calling or texting 988;

13        2. The Crisis Text Line, which can be accessed by texting HOME  
14 to 741741; and

15        3. The campus police or security telephone number or, if the  
16 campus does not have a campus police or security telephone number,  
17 the local nonemergency telephone number.

18        C. If a school district or charter school subject to the  
19 provisions of subsection A of this section or an institution of  
20 higher education subject to the provisions of subsection B of this  
21 section has a supply of unissued student identification cards that  
22 do not comply with subsections A and B of this section, as  
23 applicable, as of July 1, 2023, the school or institution of higher  
24

1 education may issue the non-compliant student identification cards  
2 until the supply is depleted.

3 D. Subsections A and B of this section shall apply to a student  
4 identification card issued for the first time to a student and to a  
5 student identification card issued to replace a damaged or lost  
6 student identification card.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
