1 ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 1318 By: Jech of the Senate 2 and 3 Newton of the House 4 5 An Act relating to vehicle registration; amending 47 6 O.S. 2021, Section 1137.3, which relates to registration or licensing after purchase; modifying 7 deadline for registration and removal of temporary license plate for certain purchases; updating 8 statutory language; and declaring an emergency. 9 10 11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA: 12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 1137.3, is 13 amended to read as follows: Section 1137.3. The purchaser of every new and used motor 14 vehicle, travel trailer or commercial trailer shall register or 15 license the same within thirty (30) days from the date of purchase 16 sixty (60) days from the date of purchase for purchases made on or 17 after the effective date of this act. It shall be the 18 responsibility of the selling dealer to place a temporary license 19 plate, in size similar to the permanent Oklahoma license plate but 20 of a weatherproof plastic-impregnated substance approved by the 21 Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission, upon a new motor vehicle, travel 22 trailer or commercial trailer when a transaction is completed for 23 the sale of said the vehicle or trailer. Except for cab and chassis 24

trucks, the temporary license plate under this section shall be placed at the location provided for the permanent motor vehicle license plate. The purchaser of a new cab and chassis truck may place the temporary license plate under this section in the rear window. Said The temporary license plate shall show the dealer's license number which is issued to him or her each year by the Oklahoma Tax Commission, the date the new motor vehicle, travel trailer or commercial trailer was purchased and the company name of the selling dealer. The Oklahoma Motor Vehicle Commission is hereby directed to develop a temporary license plate design to incorporate these requirements in a manner that will permit law enforcement personnel to readily identify the dealer license number and date of the vehicle purchase. The Motor Vehicle Commission is further authorized to develop additional requirements and parameters designed to discourage or prevent illegal duplication and use of the temporary license plate. On or before sixty (60) days from the date of purchase for purchases made on or after the effective date of this act and before July 1, 2023, and thirty (30) days from the date of purchase of a new motor vehicle, travel trailer or commercial trailer, for purchases made before the effective date of this act, said the temporary license plate shall be removed and replaced with a permanent, current Oklahoma license plate. Use of said the temporary license plate by a licensed dealer for other than the

1 purpose of normally doing business shall constitute grounds for revocation of the dealer's license. It shall be unlawful for any licensed dealer of new motor 3 vehicles, travel trailers or commercial trailers to procure the 4 5 registration and licensing of any new motor vehicle, travel trailer or commercial trailer sold by such licensed dealer or to act as the 6 agent for such purchaser in the procurement of said the registration 7 and licensing. The license of any licensed dealer of new motor 9 vehicles, travel trailers or commercial trailers violating the provisions of this section shall be revoked. 10 SECTION 2.
