5 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
6 amending 59 O.S. 2021, Section 1750.4, which relates
7 to required licenses; modifying requirements;
8 requiring unarmed security guards to obtain a certain
license; prohibiting certain persons from operating
as unarmed security guards; and providing an
effective date.

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11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 1750.4, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1750.4. A. On and after January 1, 1988, no person may
15 be employed or operate as a security guard, private investigator,
16 security agency, or investigative agency until a license therefor
17 has been issued by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and
18 Training pursuant to the Oklahoma Security Guard and Private
19 Investigator Act.

20 B. On or after November 1, 2022, a person employed or operating
21 as an unarmed security guard who has submitted a complete license
22 application to the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training
23 and who is employed by a licensed security agency shall have forty-
24 five (45) days from the date of employment to secure a license

1 issued by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training
2 pursuant to the Oklahoma Security Guard and Private Investigator
3 Act. If the application of the person is denied before forty-five
4 (45) days has expired or if the time expires prior to the issuance
5 of a license, the person shall not continue to operate as a security
6 guard until such time as a proper license is issued.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
