9 An Act relating to firearms; considering certain
10 action as infringing on the right to keep and bear
11 arms; directing courts and law enforcement agencies
12 to protect certain rights of law-abiding citizens;
13 prohibiting law enforcement officers from obeying or
14 enforcing certain orders; prohibiting the termination
15 or retaliation against law enforcement officers for
16 refusing to obey or enforce certain orders;
17 prohibiting the state, counties and municipalities
18 from making cuts to funds or budgets of county
19 sheriff offices or municipal police departments under
20 certain circumstances; defining term; providing for
21 codification; and declaring an emergency.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2201 of Title 25, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any federal, state, county or municipal act, law, executive
order, administrative order, court order, rule or regulation
ordering the confiscation of firearms, firearm accessories or

1 ammunition from law-abiding citizens of this state shall be
2 considered an infringement on the rights of citizens to keep and
3 bear arms as guaranteed by the Second Amendment of the Constitution
4 of the United States and Article II, Section 26 of the Constitution
5 of Oklahoma.

6 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2202 of Title 25, unless there
8 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 It shall be the duty of the courts and law enforcement agencies
10 of this state to protect the rights of law-abiding citizens to keep
11 and bear arms within the borders of this state and to protect these
12 rights from the infringement provided under the provisions of
13 Section 1 of this act.

14 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2203 of Title 25, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. No law enforcement officer shall obey or enforce any direct
18 or indirect order which violates the Second Amendment of the
19 Constitution of the United States, Article II, Section 26 of the
20 Constitution of Oklahoma or the law enforcement oath of the law
21 enforcement officer.

22 B. Any agency or department of the State of Oklahoma, county or
23 municipality shall be prohibited from terminating or retaliating
24 against any law enforcement officer who refuses to obey or enforce

1 any order which violates the Second Amendment of the Constitution of
2 the United States, Article II, Section 26 of the Constitution of
3 Oklahoma or the law enforcement oath of the law enforcement officer.

4 C. The State of Oklahoma and any county or municipal government
5 shall not cut any funding or budget from a county sheriff's office
6 or municipal police department for:

7 1. Refusing to obey or enforce any order which violates the
8 Second Amendment of the Constitution of the United States, Article
9 II, Section 26 of the Constitution of Oklahoma or the law
10 enforcement oath of a law enforcement officer; or

11 2. Making any county or municipality a Second Amendment
12 sanctuary county or municipality.

13 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2204 of Title 25, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 For the purposes of Sections 1 and 2 of this act, the term "law-
17 abiding citizen" shall mean a person who is not otherwise precluded
18 under federal or state law from possessing a firearm and shall not
19 be construed to include anyone who is not legally present in the
20 United States or the State of Oklahoma.

21 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
22 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
23 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
24 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
