BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1110 of Title 60, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The state shall limit the amount of public land owned by the
State of Oklahoma, state agencies, and federal government to no more
than ten percent (10%) of the total land in the state.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1111 of Title 60, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. All easements granted to or reserved by the federal
government, on or after the effective date of this act, for land

1 located in the State of Oklahoma shall be for a period of thirty
2 (30) years or less.

3 B. All easements granted to or reserved by the State of
4 Oklahoma or state agencies shall be for a period of thirty (30)
5 years or less. Any easements held by the State of Oklahoma or any
6 state agency that has been owned by the state or any state agency
7 for longer than thirty (30) years are hereby released and
8 relinquished.

9 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
