18	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified			
19	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 479 of Title 59, unless there is			
20	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:			
21	A. As used in this section:			
22	1. "Board" means the Oklahoma Board of Nursing, the State Board			
23	of Osteopathic Examiners, the Oklahoma Perfusionists Board, or the			
24	State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision;			

2. "Health care employer" means a hospital, clinic, physician's
 office, ambulatory surgery center, or any entity whose employed,
 contracted, or affiliated staff provide health care services to
 individuals in this state; and

3. "Health care provider" means an individual who holds a
valid, unexpired credential granted by another state or territory
that authorizes or qualifies the individual to perform acts that are
substantially the same as the acts that any of the following are
licensed or certified to perform:

10a. a registered nurse or licensed practical nurse under11Section 567.1 et seq. of Title 59 of the Oklahoma12Statutes, or an Advanced Practice Registered Nurse13licensed under Section 567.5a et seq. of Title 59 of14the Oklahoma Statutes, and

15 b. an allopathic physician licensed under Section 480 et 16 seq. of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes, osteopathic 17 physician licensed under Section 620 et seq. of Title 18 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes, physician assistant 19 licensed under Section 519.1 et seq. of Title 59 of 20 the Oklahoma Statutes, perfusionist licensed under 21 Section 2051 of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes, or 22 respiratory care practitioner licensed under Section 23 2042 et seq. of Title 59 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

E. Nothing in this act shall be construed to allow allopathic or osteopathic physicians or surgeons, physician assistants, or Advanced Practice Registered Nurses with prescriptive authority who are issued a temporary license to initiate a prescription for controlled drugs, including opioids, without obtaining the proper permits from the following:

The Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs
 Control; and

20 2. The Drug Enforcement Administration.

F. Nothing in this act shall be construed to allow allopathic or osteopathic physicians or surgeons who are issued a temporary license to recommend medical marijuana.

The Board may charge a fee for the issuance of a temporary 3 Η. 4 emergency license under this act. 5 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2021, Section 567.15, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 Section 567.15 A. The Board may issue temporary licenses to nurses from other states upon proper application stating the purpose 8 9 of said licenses; provided no temporary license may be issued for 10 more than ninety (90) days. Temporary license may be renewed at the 11 discretion of the Board but shall not extend over a period longer 12 than one (1) year. 13 B. The Board may issue temporary licenses pursuant to 14 subsection A of this section or pursuant to the requirements of 15 Section 1 of this act. 16 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2022. 17 SECTION 4.
