Every person who breaks and enters the 16 dwelling house of another, in which there is at the time no human 17 being present, or any commercial building or any part of any 18 building, room, booth, tent, railroad car or other structure or 19 erection in which any property is kept or breaks into or forcibly 20 opens, any coin-operated or vending machine or device with intent to 21 steal any property therein or to commit any felony, is quilty of 22 burglary in the second degree. 23 B. Every person who breaks and enters, climbs under, or uses 24 any jack stands or any other item to raise any automobile, truck,

- 1 trailer or vessel of another, in which any property is kept, with
- 2 | intent to steal:
- 3 1. Steal any property therein;
- 4 2. Steal any property attached thereto; or to commit
- 5 3. Commit any felony,
- 6 | is guilty of burglary in the third degree.
- 7 <u>C. As used in subsection B of this section, the term "property</u>
- 8 attached thereto" includes, but is not limited to, tires, wheels,
- 9 and catalytic converters.
- 10 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1436, is
- 11 | amended to read as follows:
- 12 | Section 1436. Burglary is a felony punishable by imprisonment
- 13 | in the custody of the Department of Corrections as follows:
- 1. Burglary in the first degree for any term not less than
- 15 | seven (7) years nor more than twenty (20) years;
- 2. Burglary in the second degree not exceeding seven (7) years;
- 17 and
- 3. Burglary in the third degree not exceeding five (5) years,
- 19 or by a fine not exceeding Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), or by
- 20 | both such fine and imprisonment.
- 21 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
