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8 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Center for the
9 Advancement of Science and Technology; requiring that
10 portions of certain appropriated funds be utilized
11 for certain purposes; providing budgeting and
12 expenditure limitations and procedures; providing
13 lapse date; requiring and prohibiting certain budget
14 procedures; and providing for noncodification.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Center for the
19 Advancement of Science and Technology in Enrolled Senate Bill No.
20 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, One
21 Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,800,000.00) shall be
22 allocated to the Oklahoma Manufacturing Alliance for the purpose of
23 Industrial Extension Services.

24 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

1 From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Center for the
2 Advancement of Science and Technology in Enrolled Senate Bill No.
3 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, Two
4 Hundred Eighty-two Thousand Dollars (\$282,000.00) shall be allocated
5 to the Oklahoma Small Business Research Assistance.

6 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
7 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

8 From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Center for the
9 Advancement of Science and Technology in Enrolled Senate Bill No.
10 1040 of the 2nd Session of the 58th Oklahoma Legislature, Four
11 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall be allocated to
12 the Inventors Assistance Services.

13 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
14 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
15 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23) or may be
16 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24).
17 Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 30,
18 2023, and must be expended by November 15, 2023. Any funds
19 remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for FY-24, shall
20 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
21 year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June
22 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2024, shall lapse
23 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
24 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years

1 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23, and not required to pay
2 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-24, after
3 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
4 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
5 from the FY-23 budget work program and after such revision has been
6 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
