11 An Act relating to motorcycles; amending 47 O.S.
12 2021, Section 11-1103, which relates to motorcycles;
13 making certain exception; defining term; allowing
14 two-wheeled motorcycles to lane filter under certain
15 conditions; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 11-1103, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 11-1103. A. No person under the age of sixteen (16)
20 years shall drive a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, motorized
21 scooter, or motorized bicycle on any highway of this state while
22 transporting any other person.

23 B. The operator of a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, motorized
24 scooter, or motorized bicycle who has attained the age of sixteen

1 (16) years or older may carry a passenger if the vehicle has a wheel
2 diameter of twelve (12) inches or greater and is factory-designed
3 and equipped with either:

4 1. A double seating device with double foot rests; or

5 2. A sidecar attachment providing a separate seat space within
6 such sidecar attachment for each person riding therein so that such
7 person shall be seated entirely within the body of said sidecar.

8 C. No rider of a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, motorized
9 scooter, or motorized bicycle shall hold to any moving vehicle for
10 the purpose of being propelled.

11 D. ~~No~~ Except as otherwise provided by subsection E of this
12 section, no driver of a motorcycle, motor-driven cycle, motorized
13 scooter, motorized bicycle, or electric-assisted bicycle shall pass
14 other vehicles between lanes of traffic traveling in the same
15 direction. This subsection shall not apply to the operator of an
16 authorized emergency vehicle.

17 E. 1. As it is used in this subsection, the term "lane
18 filtering" means the act of a two-wheeled motorcycle overtaking and
19 passing another vehicle or vehicles that are stopped in the same
20 lane and direction of travel as the overtaking motorcycle.

21 2. An operator of a two-wheeled motorcycle may engage in lane
22 filtering when:

23 a. the operator of the motorcycle is on a roadway with
24 lanes that are wide enough to pass safely,

- 1 b. the overtaking motorcycle is not operated at a speed
2 in excess of ten (10) miles per hour when overtaking
3 or passing the stopped vehicle or vehicles, and
4 c. conditions permit continued reasonable and prudent
5 operation of the motorcycle while lane filtering.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
