9 An Act relating to higher education; requiring
10 educational institutions to provide an electronic
11 link to a certain dashboard; prescribing content of
12 dashboard; defining term; providing for codification;
13 and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3231 of Title 70, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Each educational institution within The Oklahoma State
19 System of Higher Education shall make available on its website an
20 electronic link to the Oklahoma State Regents Employment Outcomes
21 Dashboard. The Oklahoma State Regents Employment Outcomes Dashboard
22 shall include, at a minimum:

23 1. Employment data of graduates from institutions within The
24 Oklahoma State System of Higher Education;

1 2. Wages and earnings information for each major and degree
2 offered by any institution within The Oklahoma State System of
3 Higher Education of graduates employed in Oklahoma upon graduation;

4 3. Employment outcomes by county and industry code; and

5 4. A supplemental link to the United States Bureau of Labor
6 Statistics Occupational Outlook Handbook.

7 B. As used in this section, "educational institution" means any
8 public institution supported wholly or in part by direct legislative
9 appropriations and offering courses of education of any kind beyond
10 or in addition to the twelfth grade, or its equivalent, as such
11 grade is generally understood and accepted in the public school
12 system of Oklahoma, whether called a university, college, junior
13 college, school or academy.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
