9 FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to revenue and taxation; modifying  
11 rates of tax imposed on certain motor fuels;  
12 providing for increases in rates; providing for  
13 codification; and declaring an emergency.

14  
15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 500.501 of Title 68, unless  
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Upon the effective date of this act, the motor fuel tax  
20 levies otherwise imposed pursuant to the provisions of the Motor  
21 Fuel Tax Code shall be reduced as follows:

22 1. A total levy of zero percent (0%) from the effective date of  
23 this act through December 31, 2022;

1           2. A rate of five cents (\$0.05) per gallon for the month of  
2 January 2023;

3           3. A rate of ten cents (\$0.10) per gallon for the month of  
4 February 2023;

5           4. A rate of fifteen cents (\$0.15) per gallon for the month of  
6 March 2023; and

7           5. A rate of nineteen cents (\$0.19) per gallon for the month of  
8 April 2023 and for all periods thereafter.

9           B. With respect to the levy of tax on motor fuels other than  
10 gasoline or diesel fuel, the rate of tax shall be reduced as  
11 follows:

12           1. A total levy of zero percent (0%) from the effective date of  
13 this act through December 31, 2022;

14           2. A rate of twenty-six and thirty-one-hundredths percent  
15 (26.31%) of the rate that would otherwise be imposed on such fuels  
16 for the month of January 2023;

17           3. A rate of fifty-two and twenty-six-hundredths percent  
18 (52.26%) of the rate that would otherwise be imposed on such fuels  
19 for the month of February 2023;

20           4. A rate of seventy-eight and ninety-four-hundredths percent  
21 (78.94%) of the rate that would otherwise be imposed on such fuels  
22 for the month of March 2023; and

1           5. A rate of one hundred percent (100%) of the rate that would  
2 otherwise be imposed on such fuels for the month of April 2023 and  
3 for all periods thereafter.

4           SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
