Section 18. This act Section 1, Chapter 308, O.S.L. 2021 shall only become effective on and after the certification of when the Attorney General certifies that:

- 1. The United States Supreme Court overrules the central holding of has overruled in whole or in part Roe v. Wade, 410 U.S. 113 (1973), reaffirmed by and Planned Parenthood of Southeastern Pennsylvania v. Casey, 505 U.S. 833 (1992), thereby restoring to such that the State of Oklahoma the authority to prohibit abortion may enforce Section 861 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes or enact a similar statute prohibiting abortion throughout pregnancy; or
- 2. An amendment to the United States Constitution is adopted that restores to such that the State of Oklahoma the authority to prohibit abortion may enforce Section 861 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes or enact a similar statute prohibiting abortion throughout pregnancy.
- SECTION 3. REPEALER Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 18 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17, Chapter 308, O.S.L., are hereby repealed.
  - SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
