9 FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to sharing of state data; creating
11 definition of state data; stating ownership of state
12 data; requiring state agencies to comply with
13 statutory obligations; authorizing the sharing of
14 state data between state agencies; requiring
15 submission of specified information on certain form;
16 authorizing state agencies to decline requests for
17 state data; construing provision; exempting judicial
18 and legislative departments from scope of act; providing
19 for codification; and providing an effective date.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.210 of Title 62, unless there
24 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

25 A. As used in this section, "state data" means all data files
26 hosted, procured, owned, processed, secured, stored, or created by
27 this state or its state agencies, while in the course of state
28 business and shall include any and all data not otherwise prohibited

1 from such classification by state or federal law. Such data shall
2 be the property of this state unless prohibited by law.

3 B. While this state is the owner of state data, individual
4 state agencies shall comply with their respective statutory
5 obligations in managing state data including responding to open
6 records requests, reporting and responding to data breaches and any
7 other statutory obligations required when hosting, accessing,
8 storing, collecting, or processing state data.

9 C. The Chief Information Officer for the State of Oklahoma may
10 establish standards and criteria for sharing state data between state
11 agencies. Agency requests to share state data shall be denied if the
12 stated purpose does not meet the established standards and criteria
13 for sharing state data as established the CIO. State agencies may
14 decline requests to share state data if the state data requested is
15 otherwise privileged or prohibited from being shared by state or
16 federal law.

17 D. The powers provided in this section shall be in addition to
18 and not in substitution for any powers provided to the Office of
19 Management and Enterprise Services or the State Chief Information
20 Officer by rule or law.

21 E. No powers provide in this section shall exempt or supersede
22 a state agency's statutory responsibility to protect data and to
23 comply with requirements of the Oklahoma Open Records Act or
24 applicable state or federal law.

1 F. The provisions of this section shall not be applicable to
2 the judicial department of state government or any entity organized
3 within the judicial department and shall not be applicable to the
4 legislative department or any entity organized within the
5 legislative department.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
