10 FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to education; prohibiting certain
12 employees and students within certain institutions
13 from being required to engage in certain training or
14 counseling; allowing for voluntary counseling;
15 prohibiting orientation or requirement that presents
16 any form of certain stereotyping or bias; directing
17 promulgation of rules subject to certain approval;
18 prohibiting certain application; prohibiting
19 employees of certain schools from requiring certain
20 concepts to be part of a course; specifying concepts;
21 directing promulgation of rules subject to certain
22 approval; providing for codification; providing an
23 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-157 of Title 70, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 A. 1. No teacher, administrator, other employee or enrolled
2 student of an institution of higher education within The Oklahoma
3 State System of Higher Education shall be required to engage in any
4 form of mandatory gender or sexual diversity training or counseling;
5 provided, voluntary counseling shall not be prohibited. Any
6 orientation or requirement that presents any form of race or sex
7 stereotyping or a bias on the basis of race or sex shall be
8 prohibited.

9 2. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall
10 promulgate rules, subject to approval by the Legislature, to
11 implement the provisions of this subsection.

12 B. The provisions of this subsection shall not prohibit the
13 teaching of concepts that align to the Oklahoma Academic Standards.

14 1. No teacher, administrator or other employee of a school
15 district, charter school or virtual charter school shall require or
16 make part of a course the following concepts:

- 17 a. one race or sex is inherently superior to another race
18 or sex,
- 19 b. an individual, by virtue of his or her race or sex, is
20 inherently racist, sexist or oppressive, whether
21 consciously or unconsciously,
- 22 c. an individual should be discriminated against or
23 receive adverse treatment solely or partly because of
24 his or her race or sex,

- 1 d. members of one race or sex cannot and should not
2 attempt to treat others without respect to race or
3 sex,
4 e. an individual's moral character is necessarily
5 determined by his or her race or sex,
6 f. an individual, by virtue of his or her race or sex,
7 bears responsibility for actions committed in the past
8 by other members of the same race or sex,
9 g. any individual should feel discomfort, guilt, anguish
10 or any other form of psychological distress on account
11 of his or her race or sex, or
12 h. meritocracy or traits such as a hard work ethic are
13 racist or sexist or were created by members of a
14 particular race to oppress members of another race.

15 2. The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules, subject
16 to approval by the Legislature, to implement the provisions of this
17 subsection.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2021.

19 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
