11	accommodations; creating misdemeanor for improper use of service animal; stating penalty; authorizing

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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 4 O.S. 2021, Section 801, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 801. A. For purposes of this section:
19	1. The terms "place of public accommodation", "public
20	accommodation" and "service animal" shall have the same meaning as
21	such terms are defined in 28 C.F.R., Section 36.104. "Service
22	animal" does not include an emotional support animal or a therapy
23	animal;
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1 2. "Emotional support animal" means an animal selected to reside with an individual with a disability that does not work or 2 perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability and 3 does not accompany at all times an individual with a disability; and 4 5 3. "Therapy animal" means a personal pet who is certified to make therapeutic visits with a trained volunteer to places 6 including, but not limited to, nursing facilities, schools and 7 hospitals to bring therapeutic benefit, comfort and cheer to others. 8

9 B. A public accommodation may adopt a policy to prohibit
10 animals, except service animals, from entering the place of public
11 accommodation.

C. A public accommodation which adopts such a policy shall post a sign in a conspicuous location outside the entrance of the place of public accommodation stating which animals or types of animals are prohibited. Such sign shall <del>also</del> state that service animals are permitted <u>and may also include a statement pursuant to subparagraph</u> a of paragraph 2 of subsection E of this section.

D. If a public accommodation inquires into the qualification of a service animal, the public accommodation shall comply with 28 C.F.R., Section 36.302(c)(6).

E. 1. Any person who is not an individual with a disability or
is not trained to assist individuals with disabilities, who uses a
service animal in an attempt to gain treatment or benefits as an
individual with a disability shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a

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1	misdemeanor punishable by a fine not more than Five Hundred Dollars
2	<u>(\$500.00).</u>
3	2. A public accommodation may post a sign inside or outside of
4	the place of public accommodation stating:
5	a. it is a crime under state law to misrepresent an
6	animal as a service animal, and
7	b. the penalty provided by paragraph 1 of this
8	subsection.
9	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
